Version 4.10

Requirements

In order to install and use CMS pro v.4.10 you must have CMS pro v.4.06 already installed.

Upgrade

Unzip the upgrade.zip package into your local drive. If you don't have WinZip, you can download it for free <http://winzip.com>.

Using an FTP program (such as Filezilla, which is free, or a commercial package such as CuteFTP), login to your web server and copy upgrade files across into your CMS pro root directory, keeping the same file/folder structure.

Upgrade Wizard

CMS pro Upgrade includes a simple two step upgrade process. To start the upgrade wizard, navigate to the directory that you installed CMS Pro, for example: <http://www.example.com/upgrade.php>

The Upgrade wizard will appear. Follow simple on screen instructions.

Once install process is done, open up /lang/en/lang.xml and add:

```
<phrase data="_SM_DOPD">Include Photoshop Drive</phrase>
<phrase data="_PG_PROFILE">Public Profile Page</phrase>
<phrase data="_PG_PROFILE_T">If Yes it willbe used as a default public user profile
page.</phrase>

```
<!-- Public User Profile -->
<phrase data="_PPF_ERR">Selected User does not exists!</phrase>
<phrase data="_PPF_COM_P">Posted comment</phrase>
<phrase data="_PPF_ART_P">Submitted an article</phrase>
<phrase data="_PPF_FRM_P">Started forum conversation</phrase>
<phrase data="_PPF_FBLG_P">Posted blog comment</phrase>
```

Anywhere before closing </language>

Repeat the same for all other languages you have.

What's New?

Version 4.10 brings few new and existing features.

1. Public user profile page
2. Customizable slugs for pages and modules
3. New theme (wojotheme)
4. Dedicated sub header images for pages
5. New top/bottom layout configurations
6. All known bug fixes.

1. Public User Profile Page

Public user profile page could be accessed directly using the following url:

<http://yourdomain.com/profile/admin/>

Links to profile page are also available from comment section (clicking on username), blog module, blog comments etc...

2. Custom Slugs For Pages and Modules

You can now assign custom slugs for each module as well as page section.

Instead of having url structure:

<http://yourdomain.com/page/your-page-name/>

It could be easily converted into:

<http://yourdomain.com/content/your-page-name/>

The same rule applies to modules:

<http://yourdomain.com/portfolio/>

Could become:

<http://yourdomain.com/mywork/>

To make slug changes, open up `/lib/class_url.php` and look for:

```
"moddir" => array(  
    "digishop" => "digishop",  
    "blog" => "blog",  
    "portfolio" => "portfolio",  
    "booking" => "booking",  
    "psdrive" => "psdrive",  
    "forum" => "forum"  
),
```

In this section, change the keys highlighted in red. Make sure each value is unique. You should not make any changes if your site is already indexed by search engines.

Next section contains page slug:

```
"pagedata" => array(  
    "page" => "page"  
),
```

In this section, change the value highlighted in red.

Last section contains dedicated module pages:

```
"module" => array(  
    //Digishop  
    "digishop" => "digishop",  
    "digishop-cat" => "category",  
    "digishop-checkout" => "checkout",  
  
    //Blog  
    "blog" => "blog",  
    "blog-cat" => "category",  
    "blog-search" => "search",  
    "blog-archive" => "archive",  
    "blog-author" => "author",
```

```
"blog-tag" => "tag",

//Portfolio
"portfolio" => "portfolio",
"portfolio-cat" => "category",

//Booking
"booking" => "booking",

//Forum
"forum" => "forum",
"forum-topic" => "topic",
"forum-user" => "user",

//PS Drive
"psdrive" => "psdrive",
"psdrive-cat" => "category",
"psdrive-share" => "share",
"psdrive-tag" => "tag",
"booking" => "booking"
)
```

Again, change the values highlighted in red.

Renaming digishop url:

1. In first section find **digishop** and replace it with **shop**
2. In third section find digishop array and make necessary changes as well.

3. New theme - Wojotheme

New free theme is included in this update which adds support for css animations. See home page.

4. Dedicated sub header images

You can have different sub header image for each page.

Sub headers are section right bellow main header holding Page Titles, breadcrumbs etc...

To assign image to a page, first find out what your page slug is. Go to admin panel, Pages edit page and look under slug field.

Once you got the slug name upload your image using filmanager into /uploads/pages/subheaders/**current theme**/

Your image must be named exactly as page slug. For example if your page slug is called **contact-us**, your image name must be **contact-us.jpg**.

Cms pro will try to detect existence of this image, otherwise, default image will be used instead.

5. New Configuration top/bottom layout

You can now assign multiple plugins to top/bottom layouts, and as long as you set the maximum occupied space to 10 each plugin will be displayed in block layout, allowing you to create unlimited layout possibilities with different backgrounds.

Example of this feature is shown on new wojotheme homepage. The first three sections are just a static plugins.
